Pastor Jeff opened the meeting after many congratulations for the arrival of his new baby boy, Benjamin! Krista and baby are doing well! Pat Stillwell brought a devotional and prayer.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved with the addition of Jim Truett's name as attending.

Bruce Farlow reported that our giving was very poor, and we will need to adjust our budget at our next meeting. The coffeehouse construction was discussed. Many thanks to John Buckner for all his work on this project. Funds are still needed.

Pastor Jeff reported that Charlene Shelton had chosen the second parent representative for the CEC Committee. See attached. There was no opposition to this.

Our next business meeting is April 23rd. There will be no business meetings in May and June.

The following were asked to serve on an ad hoc committee for building usage: Frank Richardson, John Buckner, Christy Duyck, and Bruce Farlow. The motion passed.

Jim Truett mentioned that since we often do not have a quorum at our business meetings, does the Leadership Team have the authority to make decisions. It was voiced that we still need to keep the church informed, and we are still in the learning stages.

Dan Nix brought information concerning a problem with our heat in the Educational Building. The part to fix this would cost \$929.00 plus 1-2 hours labor. Discussion followed. Doley Bell moved that we proceed with fixing this and Bruce would find the money. The motion passed.
